In August 2012 Dr. Dovigi retired from academia at Midwestern University and now resides in San Diego providing Oral Medicine services in addition to biopsy service. He is currently director of Oral Pathology Diagnostic Services and now with Dr. Eversole provides service to California, Arizona, a number of neighboring states and Canada.

Vitelio Aguilar, Jr. is the provider educator in the Los Angeles area. After receiving his Degree in Social Work from Whittier College, he gained a wealth of experience working with at-risk youth and families in need. As a case manager in the Los Angeles community, he has been involved with the implementation of the Domestic Assault Response Team with California Hospital Medical Center and the Youth Advocacy Program through the Los Angeles Police Department. Serving as an Outreach Coordinator for a local nonprofit agency for ten years, he also brings the experience of promoting and strengthening awareness of various social issues through public speaking and has been a guest speaker on various television, radio, internet, and community education workshops. Vitelio is Bilingual in English and Spanish.
