Dr. Balasarian is active in Orange County Dental Society serving as delegate to California Dental Association House of Delegates annual meeting and current board member. He is a Diplomate of American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and a fellow in the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons and American College of Surgeons. He will be speaking on **"3-Dimensional Ridge Augmentation for Dental Implant Placement"**.



Nova Aghbashian, DDS, obtained his Bachelor of Science in Oral & Dental Medicine & Surgery (B.D.S) from College of Dentistry, University of Baghdad, Iraq.
