**Sharon Yeghayan, MD** is a board certified neurologist with specialized training in neuromuscular medicine. She completed her undergraduate studies at USC, obtained her medical degree from the University of Vermont and her general Neurology training from the University of Arizona. She then earned two additional fellowships in Neuromuscular diseases from Mayo clinic in Rochester, Minnesota and from UCLA. Dr. Yeghayan will be speaking on "The Armenian Patient with Dementia: Overcoming Diagnostic and Management Barriers"



Currently she serves as a voluntary clinical professor of neurology at the Department of Neurology at UCLA where she works with the fellows in the neuromuscular medicine section. She has been appointed teaching faculty at Huntington Hospital where she is also on the code-stroke team. She is also on staff at Glendale Memorial Hospital and Citrus Valley Hospital. She is an active board member with the California Neurology Society and enjoys advocacy work. She has a thriving outpatient practice based out of Pasadena where she cares for patients with a wide-variety of neurological problems. She is currently the only specialist in Autonomic disorders in all of Los Angeles County and has a large referral base for her expertise in diseases of the nerve and muscles. She feels passionate about the topic of dementia when it comes to the Armenian patients and feels that she is in a unique position to advocate for them based on being multi-lingual.
