

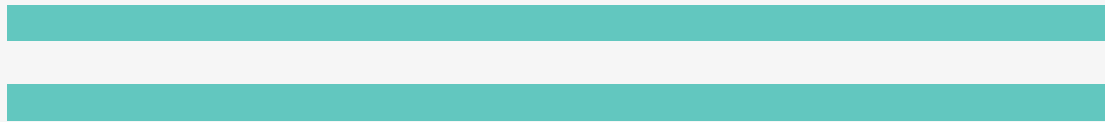

Dr. Manuel Momjian graduated from the University of Southern California, Keck School of Medicine in 2005. He is board certified in Family Medicine and is the founder and lead physician at Urgent 9, Urgent Care Center. This facility is designed as a cost-effective alternative to expensive and overcrowded emergency rooms. In March 2016, Dr. Momjian developed and implemented a revolutionary service called Urgent 9, Virtual Visits where patients can consult a doctor from the comfort of their home or office. Dr. Momjian was a past vice-president of the Armenian American Medical Society, past chairman of the organizing committee of the Glendale Health Festival, and a current clinical preceptor for the USC, Keck School of Medicine, Department of Family medicine. Dr. Momjian also enjoys educating the public on various health related topics and he has been featured on multiple television news stations including ABC7, KTLA5, KCAL9, and KVEA



Telemundo. He will be speaking on the following topic: "**Affordable Care Act from a Physicians Point of View**".
