Paola Aghajanian, MD is the Director of Labor & Delivery and the Maternal Fetal Care Unit at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center. She is a perinatologist with board certifications in Obstetrics and Gynecology, and Maternal Fetal Medicine. She also holds appointments as Assistant Professor of OB/GYN at the UCLA Geffen School of Medicine as well as at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center. She will be speaking on "Screening and Diagnosis of Fetal Chromosomal Abnormalities in Pregnancy. What options do pregnant women have in 2016?"

After earning her Bachelor's degree in Molecular and Cell Biology, Phi Beta Kappa, from the University of California at Berkeley, Dr. Aghajanian earned her medical degree from the University of California, San Diego School of Medicine. She completed her Obstetrics and Gynecology residency at the University of California, Los Angeles Medical Center, followed by a fellowship in Maternal-Fetal Medicine at the Los Angeles County - University of Southern California Medical Center.

Dr. Aghajanian's research interests include preterm labor, autoimmune disease in pregnancy, multiple gestation and fetal therapy. She is the author of several peer reviewed publications and four book chapters about problems in pregnancy. She is the recipient of awards for teaching and for her educational videos on women's health presented in American Sign Language.

Vardui Asiryan, MD received her medical degree from Yerevan State Medical University, Armenia, with honors. She was admitted to the Obstetrics and Gynecology residency training program at the

I.M. Sechenov First Moscow State Medical University (1st MSMU) which is the oldest and the largest national medical higher educational institution in the Russian Federation. She will be speaking on "Management of Menopausal Symptoms".



She also completed her Obstetrics and Gynecology residency at the Bronx-Lebanon Hospital Center, Albert Einstein College of Medicine where she gained experience in managing a wide variety of high risk obstetric and gynecologic cases with multiple comorbidities. In addition, she performs complex gynecologic surgeries including laparoscopy and laparotomy. In recognition of her organizational skills, Dr. Asiryan was elected to the position of Administrative Chief Resident by her colleagues. Upon completion of her residency, Dr. Asiryan served as an OB/GYN attending at Riverside Community Hospital affiliated with the University of Riverside. Currently she works in private practice in Glendale.
