Greg Asatrian, DDS, is currently the first year chief resident in orthodontics at UCLA School of Dentistry. Dr. Asatrian received his doctoral degree from the UCLA School of Dentistry in 2016 during which he inducted as a member of the national dental honor society, omicron kappa upsilon. As a resident, he works to implement his expertise in technology with patient care and as such has been advancing orthodontic treatment planning and therapy by utilizing 3D technology. In conjunction to his clinical education, Dr. Asatrian is a prolific researcher in tissue engineering, authoring 28 peer-reviewed journals/books and presenting at over 50 domestic and international conferences. His research revolves around the investigation of novel biologics for bone regeneration, and he

is currently a candidate for a master's of science in oral biology at UCLA. Dr. Greg Asatrian will be speaking on "**Harnessing 3D Technology in Orthodontics.**"

Dr. Nishan Odabashian received his DMD degree from Tufts University School of Dental Medicine in 1991. After practicing Restorative and Preventive Dentistry in Glendale, till 1999, he committed to residency in Endodontics at Loma Linda University, where he received his Certificate of Specialty in endodontics in 2001, and a Master's of Science degree in Endodontics in 2003. He is a part time Assistant Professor the Department of Graduate Endodontics at Loma Linda University Since 2003. Dr. Odabashian serves as the president of the Glendale Academy of Dentists, and is a past president of the California State Association of Endodontists, and president-elect of the International Academy of Endodontists. He has also served on different committees of both American Association of Endodontists, and International Academy of Endodontics. He has lectured locally, nationally and internationally. He will be one of the featured speakers in New Orleans, at the AAE's Annual meeting this April.



Dr. Odabashian will be speaking on "Minimally Invasive Endodontics: What's all the Fuss About?"



Dr. Demerjian is an expert in Neuronatomy, Pain Patterns, Trigger Points, the Trigeminal Branch/Nerve and how it correlates to Neurologic Disorders. He has published several articles and research papers including how the trigeminal system is connected to neurologic disorders. His most recent article has to do with Arthrokinetic Reflex of the Temporomandibular joint.

Dr. Demerjian has taken over 2000 hours of postgraduate education courses, in the area of TMJ, Craniofacial Pain, Sleep Disorders and Orthodontics. He has also acquired the certification of Registered Polysomnographic Technologist (RPSGT). In 2014, he joined the Fontana Kaiser Sleep Center and is Project Scientist for the Department of Oral Biology in the UCLA School of Dentistry.
