Mr. Sarian is also active in various community, charity, and civic organizations and donates countless volunteer hours as an executive board member of the California Hospital Association and is a board member of the Venice Family Clinic. He also actively supports Armenia's hospital, Armenian churches, Armenian schools, ANC, and the ARS. Through his company, he recently helped donate medical equipment in excess of \$2 million to hospitals in Armenia. In 2015, Mr. Sarian received the prestigious Ellis Island Medal of Honor for his exemplary contributions to his community.
