

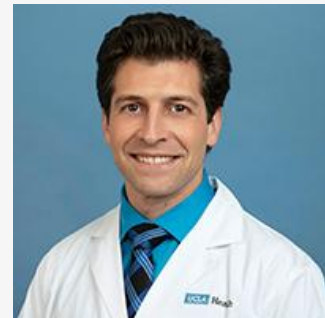
AAMS' 16th Annual CME & CDE Las Vegas Getaway

He completed his undergraduate degree in biochemistry with a minor in anthropology at UCLA. He obtained his medical degree from New York Medical College, after which he completed residency in internal medicine and fellowship in infectious diseases at UCLA. He received a Diploma in Tropical Medicine and Hygiene from the Gorgas Course in Clinical Tropical Medicine in Lima, Peru. Currently, Dr. Janoian is a clinical instructor in the Division of Infectious Diseases at UCLA where he has an active clinical practice in general infectious diseases and tropical medicine and is also active in global health education. Dr. Janoian will be speaking on the following topic: **"Tick-Borne Diseases In the United States: A Call to Action"**.
