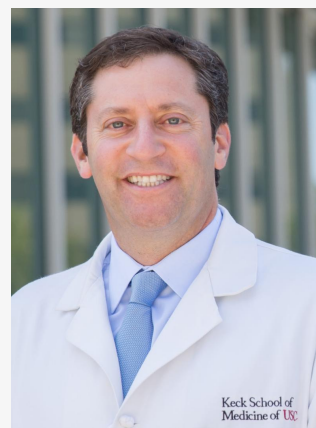


AAMS' 16th Annual CME & CDE Las Vegas Getaway

Eric Kezirian, MD, MPH is an otolaryngologist-head and neck surgeon and one of the world's leading surgeons and researchers specializing in the treatment of snoring and obstructive sleep apnea. He is Professor and Vice Chair in the USC Caruso Department of Otolaryngology - Head & Neck Surgery at the Keck School of Medicine of USC in Los Angeles, California. He is a Past President of the International Surgical Sleep Society, the world's premiere organization dedicated to sleep surgery. Dr. Kezirian has dedicated his entire career to the surgical treatment of snoring and obstructive sleep apnea, one of the few surgeons in the world to do so. Dr. Kezirian has led research funded by the National Institutes of Health and other organizations considering fundamental questions facing patients and surgeons related to sleep disorders and surgical treatment.
