He is also a Diplomate for the American Board of Craniofacial Dental Sleep Medicine (ABCDSM) where he has treated patients for Obstructed Sleep Apnea, snoring, daytime drowsiness, and patients who are CPAP intolerant. Aside from lecturing and presenting in academic settings and educational meetings, Dr. Ariz is highly involved in TMJ & Sleep Therapy Research for non-surgical therapy for improved quality of life. Dr. Ariz is the program leader in fundamentals courses in American Academy of Craniofacial Pain. Dr. Ariz is also the Vice President & Scientific Chair of Iranian American Dental Association.
