A Call To Action: Join Dr. Harma Turbendian On A Medical Mission To Yerevan

Meg Sird / Մեկ Սիրս Mission to Improve Cardiac Care in Armenia

This is the initial trip for a multifaceted project that aims to improve electronic medical record keeping, create a cardiac database/registry, establish prenatal/postnatal/adolescent/adult cardiac screening programs, provide outreach outside of Yerevan (including portable echocardiography), and educate (within the medical center and beyond.) The project is supported by the Thoracic Surgery Foundation / Edwards Lifesciences Every Heartbeat Matters Award and is being conducted in partnership with Nork Marash Medical Center in Yerevan.

Participants are responsible for travel costs. Anticipated travel is March 12 to March 21, 2021. The project is open (but not limited) to all pediatric and adult cardiology and cardiac surgery-related practitioners (cardiologists, cardiac surgeons, fellows, intensivists, anesthesiologists, nurses, perfusionists, sonographers, etc) as well as public health specialists.
