Carolyn Kassabian, MD, received her Bachelor of Science in Biology and graduated summa cum laude from UCLA. She subsequently attended the USC Keck School of Medicine, becoming a member of the Alpha Omega Alpha (AOA) Honor Society as a junior. In her final year of medical school, she served as the president of the AOA Gamma Chapter. Dr. Kassabian completed her dermatology residency at USC, where she served as co-chief resident in her last year. She is board-certified in dermatology and a fellow of the American Academy of Dermatology.
