

**Alfred Danielian, MD, FACC, FASE**, is the Director of Sports Cardiology and Echocardiography at Las Vegas Heart Associates, an affiliate of Mountain View Hospital in Las Vegas, NV. He completed his Internal Medicine Internship, Residency and Cardiology Fellowship at the University of Connecticut Medical School, where he also served as Chief Medical Resident and Chief Fellow. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Internal Medicine in Internal Medicine and Cardiovascular Disease, Diplomate of the National Board of Echocardiography, Diplomate of the Certification Board of Nuclear Cardiology, and Registered Physician in Vascular Interpretation. Dr. Danielian has a particular interest and passion for the care of the athlete's heart. He is an active member of the American College of Cardiology Sports and Exercise Cardiology Section Leadership Council, serving as a leader in the field of Sports Cardiology with numerous peer-reviewed national and international publications. He is the team cardiologist for the Vegas Golden Knights, Las Vegas Raiders, Las Vegas Aces, UNLV Athletics, Henderson Silver Knights, Las Vegas NBA Summer League, Las Vegas Aviators, and Cirque du Soleil. **Dr. Danielian will be speaking on the following topic: "Sudden Cardiac Death in Young Athletes"**
